

## RESOLUTION NO.4, 2025

### **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A RENEWAL OF THE SEVEN (7) MILL TAX LEVY ON THE CURRENT REAL PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR REAL PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, CERTIFYING SAID RESOLUTION TO THE HAMILTON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of St. Bernard, Village Council has determined that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the Village of St. Bernard, and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of that amount to meet the current expenses of the subdivision; and

**WHEREAS**, Village Council proposes a "renewal" seven (7) mill tax be levied to meet the current expenses of the subdivision, Village of St. Bernard, as authorized pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (A); and

**WHEREAS**, The proposed seven (7) mill levy is a "renewal" tax to be levied for five consecutive years beginning with the year 2025, tax duplicate, collectible in 2026 and thereafter for a total of five years; and

**WHEREAS**, a certificate has been received from the Hamilton County Auditor stating that the estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the Village remains constant throughout the life of the levy is calculated to be Five Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand and Thirty Eight Dollars and 00/100 Dollars (\$599,038.00) per year; and

**WHEREAS**, the question of the proposed seven (7) mill tax levy renewal is to be placed before the electors of the Village of St. Bernard on the August 5, 2025 election; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution, upon passage is to be certified to the Hamilton County Board of Elections; now therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** The St. Bernard Village Council hereby authorizes the levying of a seven (7) mill tax renewal upon all real property located within the Village of St. Bernard, Hamilton County, Ohio, and the question of the requested seven (7) mill tax levy renewal be placed before the electors of the Village of St. Bernard, for approval or rejection, on the August 5, 2025 election.

**Section 2.** The St. Bernard Village Council has determined that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirement of the Village of St. Bernard and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation to meet the current expenses of the Village of St. Bernard as authorized pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19(A).

**Section 3.** The seven (7) mill tax renewal is to be levied for a period of five (5) consecutive years beginning with the year 2025, tax duplicate, collectible in the year 2026 and thereafter for a total of five (5) years.

**Section 4.** The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Hamilton County Board of Elections, forthwith.

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**Section 5.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is to meet the time deadlines to place the question of the proposed tax levy before the electors on the August 5, 2025 election. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately by and upon its passage, and the approval of two-thirds of the members of said Village Council. However, this Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date provided by law if approved by no more than the majority of the members of Council, and in that event, the emergency provisions herein are set at naught.
